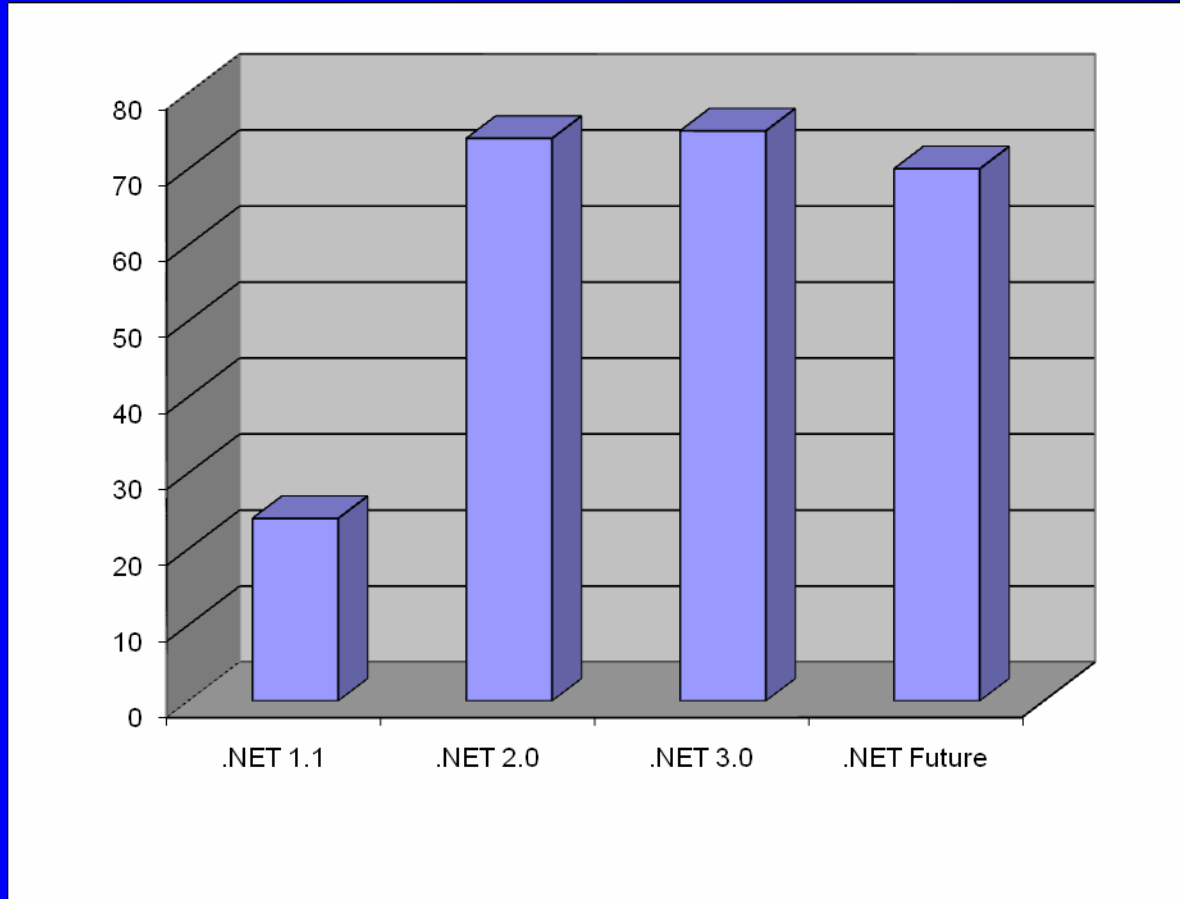

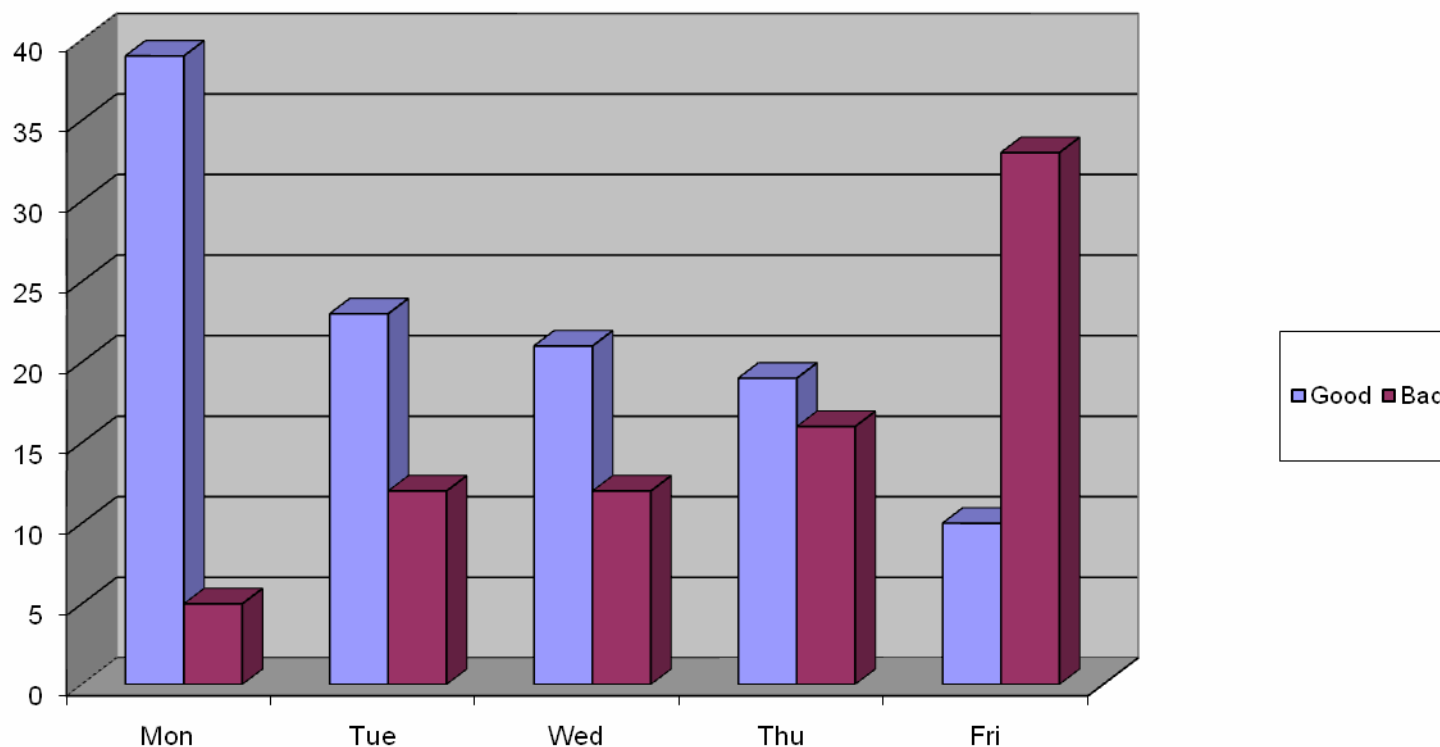

Which Version Of The .NET Framework ?



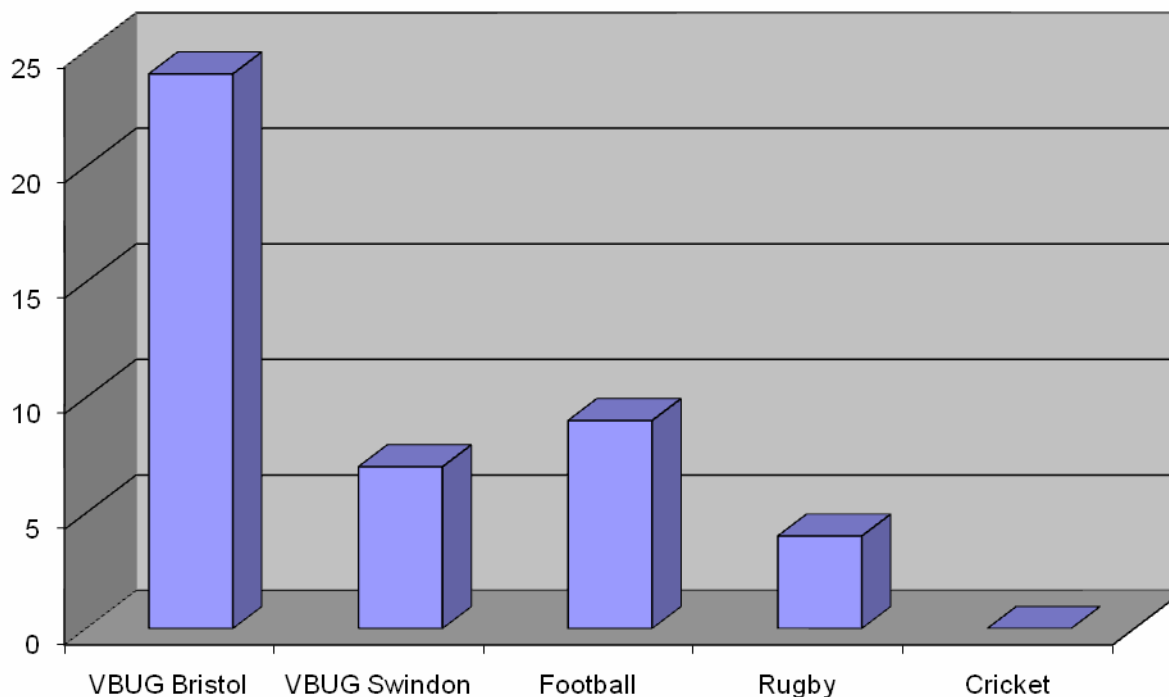
